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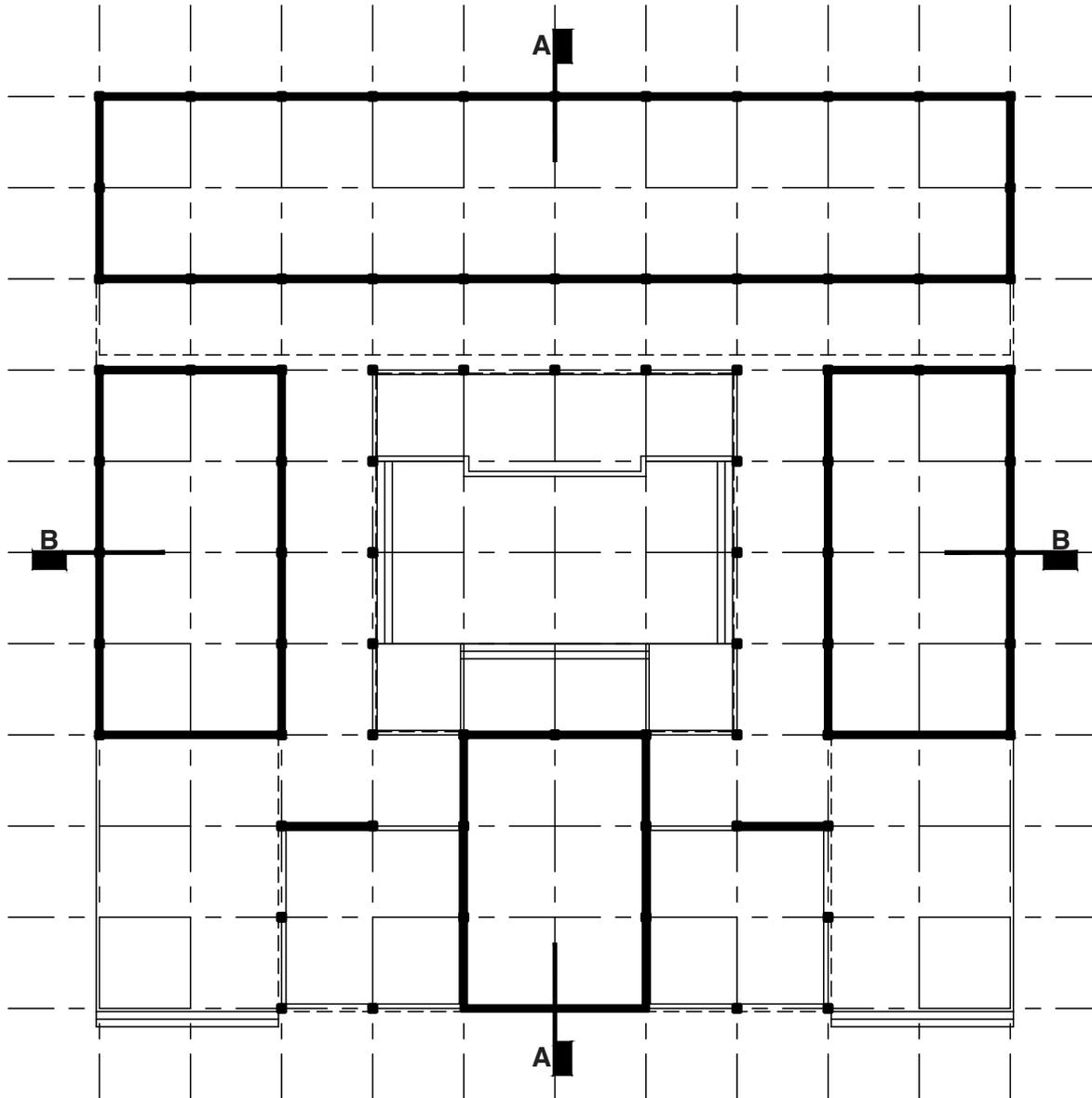

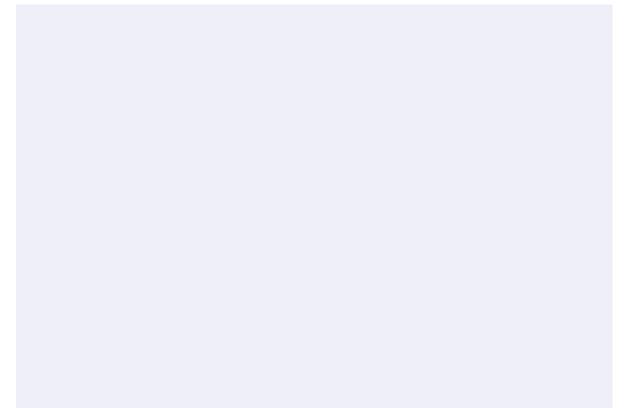

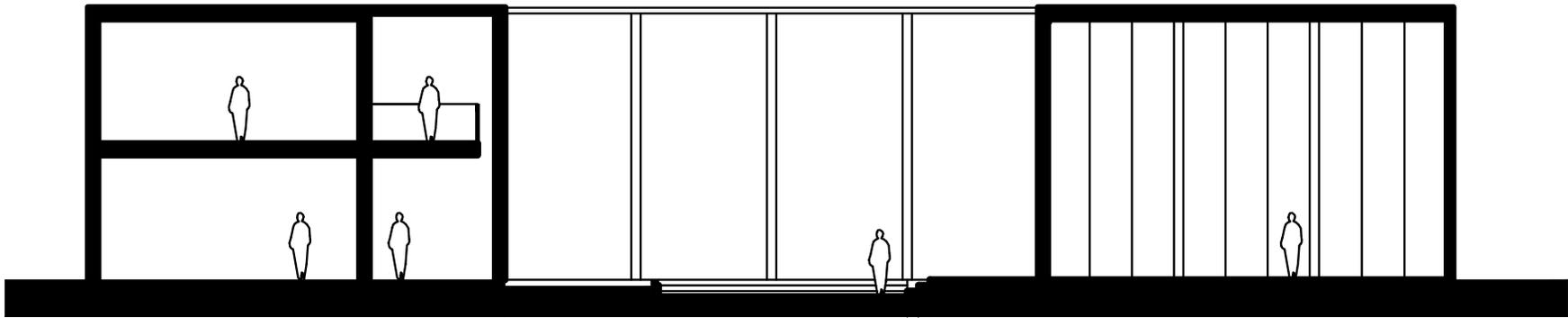
University Religious Center

With the URC building at USC as its subject, this project focused on communicating the story of the building and the experience of those interacting with it. I explored the underlying architectural principles through a 2D diagram and black and white figure fields. The topics examined include spatial relationships, grid, spatial organization, entrance, configuration of the path, path-space relationship, hierarchy, symmetry, repetitive to unique, nine-square, geometry, subtractive, and double center. These were introduced using various diagrams and emphasized by lineweight and through both hand sketching and AutoCad, Photoshop, and Illustrator design. I examined both the 2D and 3D relationships in the structure.

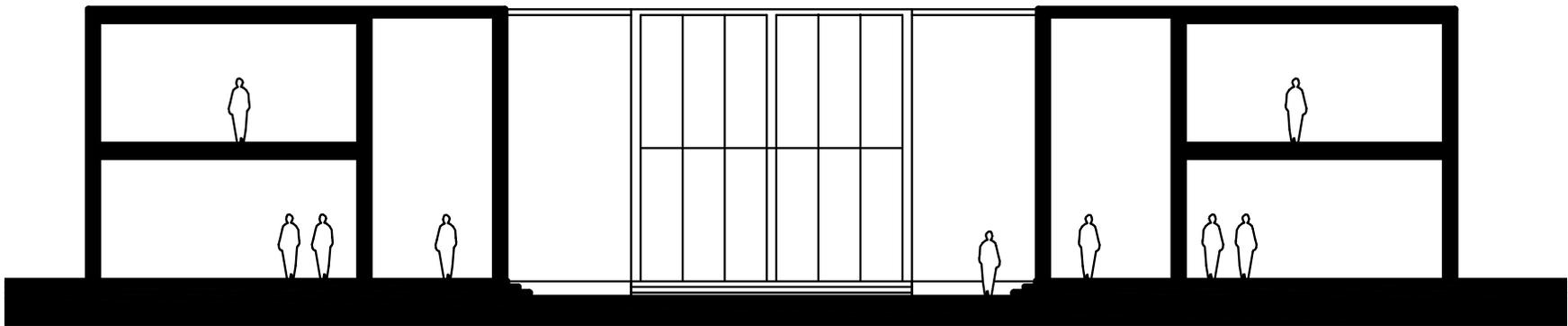

USC Leonard Davis School of Gerontology

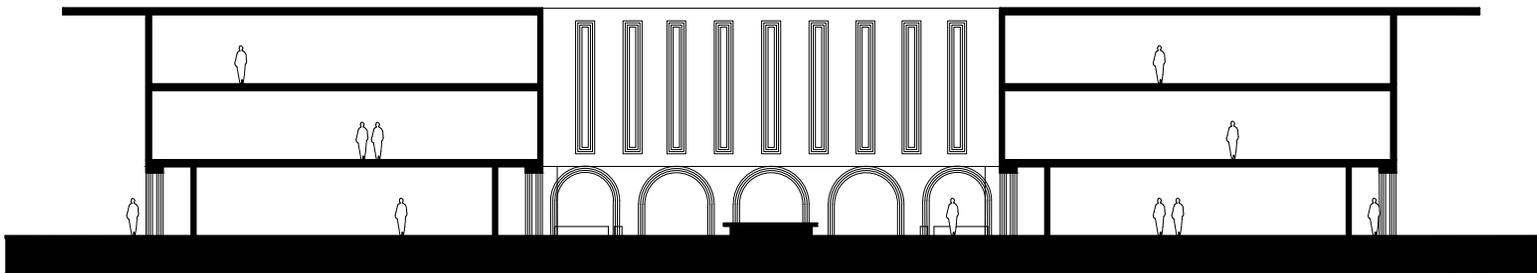
